Treasurer's Report

The book of the "North Duffield Historic Landscape Project" was selling well. 406 had been printed; some were donated to various organisations and individuals who had supported the project from the outset. Some given to various libraries, which was a legal requirement. To date, the sale of the book had generated £470.
